Frequently Asked Questions

When is New Student Orientation?

- Mandatory New Student Orientation will be held virtually, via Zoom, on January 7, 2022.
 Please plan to login via Zoom at approximately 9:00am EST. Individual event registration links will be posted via your personalized Admission's website on or before January 5th.
- <u>Virtual Howard</u>, a self-paced module, must be completed between January 5 January 14. Visit orientation.howard.edu to register and complete the <u>Virtual Howard</u> modules.
- Additional orientation programming will occur virtually during the week of January 10, 2022.

Will New Student Orientation be held virtually or in person?

New Student Orientation events will be held virtually. After the move-in date, various Schools and Colleges may elect to hold special face-to-face events at their own discretion.

How will I find out more information about New Student Orientation, Academic Advising, and other pertinent information?

Information will be sent to your <u>personalized Admission's website</u>. Once you have paid your enrollment fee and your Howard University email has been issued, additional information will be sent to your Howard University email. The email process usually takes about 72 hours to be completed once the fees have been resolved.

Your Howard University email, ending in "@bison.howard.edu" will become your official mode of communication. Once your Bison email is setup, please conduct all University business using your University-issued email address.

How do I access my Bison email account?

Is the Math Placement Exam (MPE) required?

Incoming first-year students are required to take the Math Placement Exam. There are some exceptions for students who have earned mathematics credits at previous Universities or through other channels such as advanced placement credits. Can I change my major?

Most programs have accepted students based on their enrollment capacities. Thus, incoming first-year students are generally not able to change their majors until fall 2022 (after establishing a grade point average at Howard). Policies may vary by School/College. Contact your <u>Academic Advisor</u> for more information.

Will I register for Spring 2022 classes?

Incoming first-year students will be registered by an academic advisor. Transfer students will self-register. In all cases, students should consult an <u>academic advisor</u> about their schedules.

How many classes will I take in my first semester?

All new students who have received a freshman scholarship must take a minimum of 15 credit hours (5 or 6 courses) during their first semester at Howard University.

A typical first-year first semester course schedule will consist of the following: Freshmen Seminar course, English course, Introductory Major course, Afro-Cluster course, and Elective courses (2).

Who is my Academic Advisor? How do I schedule an appointment with my academic advisor? All new (first-year and transfer) students are assigned an academic advisor. During Orientation, you will have the opportunity to hear from an advisor to learn more about University requirements, degree requirements, and your course schedule.
