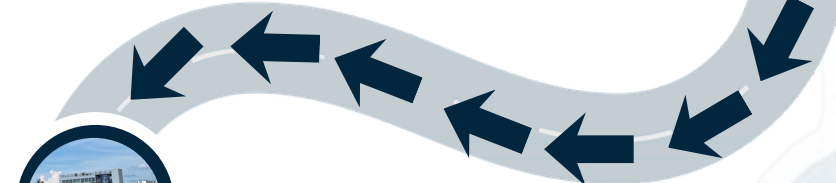

10. This African American actor captivated European audiences with his portrayal of several Shakespearian roles. There is a theater on campus that bears his name. Who is the actor?

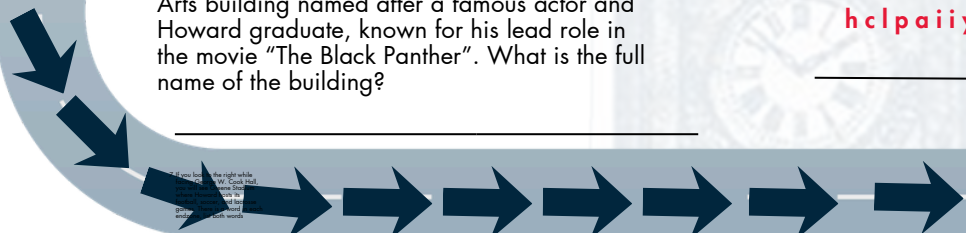
9. What is the name of the statue in front of Cramton Auditorium dedicated to former President James E. Cheeks and the First Lady of Howard University?
